- 6:00am Arrival at your school of a washroom equipped, climate controlled, highway motor coach.
- 6:30am Board your motor coach and depart for Ottawa! En route, your Tour Leader will get to know the students on a first name basis and lead discussions.
Take highway #407 to and from your destination.
- 12:00pm Own arrangements for lunch in the Byward Market. This is also a perfect opportunity to do some souvenir shopping.
- 1:30pm **Parliament Hill Centre Block Tour**
Situated on a cliff overlooking the Ottawa River, the Parliament Buildings are historical monuments, architectural treasures, and an important national symbol cherished by all Canadians. It is within the walls of these buildings that Senators and Members of Parliament debate the important issues of the day, and make our nation's laws (subject to availability).
- 2:45pm **Visit the National Military Cemetery**
Located at Beechwood Cemetery in Ottawa, the National Military Cemetery (NMC) is a national focal point honouring those who maintained Canada's commitment to peace and security, both internationally and at home.
- 4:00pm **Self Guided Visit at the Canadian War Museum**
This stunning structure on the banks of the Ottawa River houses the largest military history collection in Canada and spans the period from The Seven Years' War to the present.
- 7:00pm Dinner on your own.
- 8:00pm **Historic Walking Tour of Ottawa**
Walk through Ottawa's history with your Tour Leader. You will be captivated by the stories and legends told by your Tour Leader highlighting Ottawa's rich history as our Nation's Capital. Stops will be made at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the National War Memorial.
- 9:30pm Return to you accommodations on foot.

Day Two

- 8:00am Board your motor coach.
- 8:30am **Full Breakfast**
Enjoy a hot breakfast at a local restaurant.
- 9:30am **Canada's Remembrance Day Ceremony**
The group will find a place at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the National War Memorial: the site of solemn proceedings of Canada's Remembrance Day Ceremony. NOTE: Groups should aim to arrive at 9:30 a.m. The Ceremony begins at approximately 10:45 a.m. and ends around 12:00 p.m.
- 12:00pm **Rideau Centre**
Lunch on your own at the Rideau Centre. With more than a dozen places to eat, the Rideau Centre has something for everyone. After lunch, the students may be permitted some time to explore the mall.
- 2:00pm **Guided Tour at Diefenbunker: Canada's Cold War Museum**
Not merely an underground engineering wonder designed to protect Canadian leaders in the event of nuclear attack, it is a focal point of Canadian involvement in the Cold War.
- 4:00pm Board your motor coach and depart for home. Appropriate rest and meal stops will be made en route.
- 9:00pm **Welcome Home!**
Approximate time of arrival at the school.
