- 2:30pm **Guided walking tour including Notre Dame Basilica**  
Guided walking tour of Old Montreal including Notre Dame Basilica provided by local professional guides. Your walking tour will include information on history, architecture, and many stories of Old Montreal, from yesterday to today!
- 5:00pm **Hotel Standard - Hotel Check In**

- 9:30am **Visit the Biodome & Cable Car Ride at the Olympic Park**  
"Get an eyeful" combination pass which includes the cable car ride up to the Olympic Park Observatory and the Biodome. Inherited from the games of the XXI Olympiad, the Olympic Park is made up of the Stadium, the Montréal Tower, the Sports Centre, the fields and the outside grounds. The view of Montréal from the observation tower is as unique as it is exceptional. On a clear day, visitors can see up to 80 kilometres all around, including the Laurentian Mountains.

- 1:30pm Board your motor coach and depart for Ottawa.
- 4:00pm **Parliament Hill Centre Block Tour**  
Situated on a cliff overlooking the Ottawa River, the Parliament Buildings are historical monuments, architectural treasures, and an important national symbol cherished by all Canadians. It is within the walls of these buildings that Senators and Members of Parliament debate the important issues of the day, and make our nation's laws (subject to availability).

Visit death row and the gallows inside the Old Carleton County Jail and other haunted locations while your tour guide recounts some of Ottawa's supernatural encounters.

- Cycling Along the Rideau Canal**  
Embark on your bike tour along the Rideau Canal. Follow your guide along the historic canal to Dows Lake and enjoy the splendid scenery and the wind on your cheeks. Ottawa boasts some of the best recreational pathways in North America and what better way for groups to explore the nation's capital. NOTE: Tours operate rain or shine.
- 12:00pm **Rideau Centre**  
Lunch on your own at the Rideau Centre. With more than a dozen places to eat, the Rideau Centre has something for everyone. After lunch, the students may be permitted some time to explore the mall.

- 2:00pm **NCC's Capital Circuit: An Urban Scavenger Hunt**  
An urban scavenger hunt created by students for students: 6 clues, 6 pictures and 60 minutes. Good luck.
- 3:15pm **Guided Grand Tour at the Canadian War Museum**  
This tour provides an introduction to the Museum's award-winning architecture, its collection of war art, and its large military vehicles. This stunning structure on the banks of the Ottawa River houses the largest military history collection in Canada, and spans the period from The Seven Years' War to the present day.
- 5:00pm Return to your accommodations to refresh for this evening's activities.
- 6:30pm **Dinner and DJ Dance at Camp Fortune**  
Enjoy a buffet feast and after dinner, the group will enjoy a dance.
