- 7:30am Arrival at your school of a washroom equipped, climate controlled, highway motor coach.

- 9:00pm **Meet the Streets - Boston**
With your Tour Leader and a map, explore Boston's points of interest and discover what makes this city unique! Enjoy 2 slices of pizza and a soft drink while you interact.

Day Two

- 7:45am **Continental breakfast at your hotel**
- 8:30am Board your motor coach.
- 9:30am **Freedom Trail Walking tour (Boston Common-Quincy Mkt)**
A costumed character will bring history to life for students along Boston Freedom Trail. The player will lead your group through the story of America's founding and the birth of the United States' freedom.
- 11:20am **New England Aquarium - Self-guided visit**
Visit the New England Aquarium where students will increase their understanding of aquatic life and environments through exhibits that showcase diversity and highlight aquatic issues of importance. In The New Balance Foundation Marine Mammal Center, students will see the Northern fur seals in the new exhibit space with an amazing view of Boston Harbor.

- 12:45pm Time to explore the area around Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall. This cobblestone promenade is filled with jugglers, magicians, mimes and bands who entertain a constant influx of passersby.
- Lunch on your own at Quincy Market.
- 2:30pm Board your motor coach.
- 4:00pm **Salem Witch Museum - Guided tour**
The Salem Witch Museum brings you back to Salem Witch Trials of 1692. Students are given a dramatic history lesson using stage sets, life-size figures, lighting and narration.
- 5:30pm Dinner on your own in Salem.
- 7:00pm **Haunted Footsteps Ghost Tour**
Walk through Salem's eerie streets with your local tour guide from Haunted Footsteps Ghost Tour. Shiver as costumed guides tell true tales of documented hauntings, local history, murder and witchcraft.
- 8:30pm Board your motor coach and return to your accommodations.

Day Three

- 7:00am **Continental breakfast at your hotel**
- 8:00am Board your motor coach.
- 9:15am **Plimoth Plantation, Mayflower II Ship and Plymouth Rock**
Self-guided tour of Plimoth Plantation, a living history museum of 17th-century Plymouth and the Pilgrims that lived there. Following your visit to the Plantation, step on board the Mayflower II where you will hear stories of the hardship on the voyage to America.
- 11:30am Lunch on your own and free time to explore the neighborhood of Mayflower II.

Day Three

2:30pm **Fenway Park - Guided Tour**

Get a behind the scenes look of America's most beloved ballpark, Fenway Park. Groups can visit the press box and broadcast booths the .406 Club; the Dugout Seats; and Pesky's Pole. When the field is available, fans may also have the opportunity to walk along the warning track and come face-to-face with the fabled Green Monster.

4:15pm **Skywalk Observatory**

At the Skywalk Observatory, Boston's ONLY sky-high vantage point, you'll find panoramic 360 degree views of Greater Boston and beyond. On a clear day, visibility is more than 80 miles. Don't forget to explore the Dreams of Freedom Immigration Museum exhibits and enjoy "Wings Over Boston," the spectacular aerial video tour of the city.

6:00pm **Explore Harvard University**

Explore the grounds of Harvard University with your Tour Leader. Harvard University is the oldest institution of higher learning in the United States.

7:00pm Dinner on your own at Harvard Square.

8:30pm Board your motor coach and return to your accommodations.
