It is within the walls of these buildings that Senators and Members of Parliament debate the important issues of the day, and make our nation's laws (subject to availability).

3:30pm **Winterlude's Snowflake Kingdom**

Snowflake Kingdom is the largest snow playground on the continent and offers huge snow slides, an ice maze and extraordinary snow sculptures. A sure place to visit during Winterlude.

- 9:15am **Guided Grand Tour at the Canadian War Museum**
This tour provides an introduction to the Museum's award-winning architecture, its collection of war art, and its large military vehicles. This stunning structure on the banks of the Ottawa River houses the largest military history collection in Canada, and spans the period from The Seven Years' War to the present day.
- 10:15am Time to explore the museum in small groups.
- 11:30am **Guided Tour at the Supreme Court of Canada**
The Supreme Court of Canada has been Canada's highest court of appeal since 1949. This tour will familiarize you with the Canadian judicial system and how the decisions made by the Supreme Court Justices affect all Canadians.
- 12:30pm **Byward Market**
Time to explore and have lunch on your own in the Byward Market, one of Canada's oldest and largest public markets. The legendary builder of the Rideau Canal Lieutenant Colonel John By laid out the plan for the Market. Within its streets, you will find museums, cafés, specialty food shops, boutiques, restaurants and more.
