## **HALIFAX -** 4 Days | Atlantic Coast Music Tour

#### DAY 1

6:15 AM: Board your flight and depart for Halifax.

**10:15 AM: Arrive Halifax International Airport** where you will meet your Tour Leader. Board your motor coach and depart for the city centre.

11:00 AM: Pier 21 Visit and Multi-Media Show. Visit the Pier 21 Exhibition Hall for the chance to see the story of Canada's immigration history. This visit will include a guided tour, a screening of "In Canada," and access to the Pier 21 Resources Centre.

1:15 PM: Explore Halifax Seaport Farmers' Market. The Halifax Farmers' Market, now known as the Halifax Seaport Farmers' Market, is the oldest, continuously operating farmers' market in North America. It was established by royal decree in 1750, just one year after the establishment of Halifax itself.

1:30 PM: Lunch

**2:30 PM: Halifax Coach Tour**. Enjoy a drive and tour conducted by a local guide.

5:00 PM: Hotel check-in

6:30 PM: Dinner

**8:30 PM: Dance party at the Atlantic Band Festival**. Celebrate the festival by enjoying a chaperoned dance with your classmates and other high school participants of the Atlantic Band Festival.

#### DAY 2

8:00 AM: Breakfast

**9:00 AM: Board your local school bus** and depart for Mount Saint Vincent University.

**10:00 AM: Atlantic Band Festival.** The Atlantic Band Festival starts with adjudicated performances this morning.

12:00 PM: Lunch at your own cost in the cafeteria of the campus.1:00 PM: Performance Clinics. Attend a performance clinic for your instrument.

2:45 PM: Board your school bus and depart for your next activity. 3:30 PM: Maritime Museum of the Atlantic - Self-Guided

**Visit.** Learn about the rich history of the East Coast at the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic located in the heart of Halifax's historic waterfront.

**5:30 PM: Dinner at Murphy's on Cable Wharf**. Enjoy a group dinner in historic downtown Halifax, overlooking the harbour.

**7:00 PM: Evening Concert**. Sit back, relax, and enjoy an evening of music.

#### DAY 3

8:00 AM: Breakfast

**9:00 AM: Peggy's Cove and Lunenburg Tour.** Meet a local guide at your accommodations and depart for Peggy's Cove.

**10:00 AM: Explore Peggy's Cove.** Visit the historic Lighthouse at Peggy's Cove. Don't forget to take a picture for mom and dad. A stop will be made at the memorial for the ill-fated Swiss Air flight 111.

11:00 AM: Board your motor coach and depart for Lunenburg via Mahone Bay.

1:00 PM: Explore Old Town Lunenburg. Lunenburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, was established in 1753 as the first British colony in North America outside of Halifax. View Bluenose II. A trip to Nova Scotia would not be complete without viewing the Bluenose II, a perfect example of Nova Scotia's fabled Tall Ships. Lunenburg is the home port of Bluenose II and the birthplace of the original Bluenose.

1:30 PM: Lunch

3:30 PM: Board your school bus and return to Halifax.

**5:00 PM:** Halifax Shopping Centre. With over 170 shops and a massive food court the group will have an evening to relax and spend time with their friends as they explore the Halifax Shopping Centre.

8:00 PM: Symphony Nova Scotia. Enjoy a concert performed by Symphony Nova Scotia at the Rebecca Cohn Auditorium. Program: Beethoven: Fidelio. Fidelio will be semi-staged, 2.5 hours in length, and sung in German with English subtitles. Featuring singers from the LAMP Emerging Artists Residencies program.

#### DAY 4

8:00 AM: Breakfast

10:00 AM: Guided Tour of the Halifax Citadel. Walk along the ramparts of the Halifax Citadel National Historic Site while your tour guide tells you stories about this special place and what life was like for the soldiers stationed here in the late 1800s. You will hear how this fort played a key role in the growth of Halifax and Canada.

11:15 AM: Orientation Walk along Halifax Harbour. Your
Tour Leader will conduct an orientation walk along the
Halifax Harbour.

**12:00 PM: Halifax Harbour**. Enjoy some free time to explore Halifax Harbour on your own. Have lunch at your own cost in the area.

2:15 PM: Board your motor coach and depart for the airport.

5:00 PM: Depart on your flight home.
