NEW YORK CITY - 4 Days | Drama-Focused Student Tour

DAY 1

- 6:30 a.m. Board the motor coach (washroom-equipped & climate-controlled) and depart for New York
 City. En route, your Tour Leader will get to know the students on a first name basis.
- **9:00 a.m. Border Crossing.** Make sure your passport and any other important documents are in a safe and accessible place for border agents.
- 6:30 p.m. Hotel check-in.
- 8:30 p.m. Times Square. Head to the heart of the Great White Way and be amazed by the bright lights and massive screens. Join the crowds on the famous Red Stairs and get caught up in the excitement as your wander through the square.
- **11:00 p.m. Night Security** each evening between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

DAY 2

- 8:45 a.m. Breakfast
- 10:30 a.m. Workshop at the Paley Center for Media. Paley Center Educators lead sessions on a wide range of subjects such as advertising, the documentary form, and the civil rights movement to build analytical thinking, viewing, and listening skills and provide insight into the roles television and radio play in our culture.
- 12:30 p.m. Lunch
- **3:00 p.m. THE RIDE.** Groups experience the surprise of improv comedy, the songs and voices of Broadway, the facts of a city sights tour, and the memory of a lifetime in this theatrical show and immersive tour.
- **5:00 p.m. Explore Central Park.** Central Park, the first landscaped public park in the United States, is one of the urban wonders of the world and a green oasis in the great concrete, high-rise landscape of New York City.
- **6:30 p.m. Rockefeller Center and 5th Avenue.** Visit New York's most famous street to shop and browse along 5th Avenue and Rockefeller Center.
- 7:00 p.m. Dinner
- **8:30 p.m. Visit Top of the Rock.** Experience unparalleled views of New York City from the Observation Deck on the 70th floor of 30 Rockefeller Plaza, in the heart of midtown Manhattan.

DAY 3

- 8:45 a.m. Breakfast
- 9:30 a.m. Board your motor coach and depart for your next activity.
- 10:30 a.m. Staten Island Ferry. Travel between Whitehall Street in lower Manhattan on a gorgeous 25-minute ferry ride. Marvel at the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island and get a photo of the skyscrapers that make up the New York skyline.
- **11:45 a.m. Brooklyn Bridge Walk.** Marvel at this engineering masterpiece and experience great views of Manhattan.
- 12:30 p.m. Visit the 9/11 Memorial. "Reflecting Absence" are twin reflecting pools that sit within the footprints of the towers. Your students will learn about the events of this day and will pay respects to the nearly 3,000 people who died in the terror attacks on September 11, 2001 and the six people killed during the bombing in February 1993.
- 1:30 p.m. Lunch
- **3:30 p.m. Making a Scene.** Work with professional actors or teachings artists on acting techniques and character development to build bold and creative acting choices.
- **5:30 p.m. Times Square.** Head to the heart of NYC for dinner and time to explore!
- **8:00 p.m. Broadway Show.** Explore a whole new world, discover what came before the yellow brick road or sing along with your favourite meerkat and warthog duo. Theatre tickets are subject to schedule and availability.
