NEW YORK CITY - 4 Days | Big Apple Student Tour

DAY 1

- 6:00 a.m. Board your washroom equipped, climate controlled highway motor coach and depart for New York City via Highway #407. En route, your Tour Leader will get to know the students on a first name basis.
- 9:00 a.m. Border Crossing. Make sure your passport and any other important documents are in a safe and accessible place for border agents.
- 6:30 p.m. Hotel check-in
- 8:30 p.m. Times Square. Head to the heart of the Great White Way and be amazed by the bright lights and massive screens.

 Join the crowds on the famous Red Stairs and get caught up in the excitement as your wander through the square.
- 11:00 p.m. **Night security** each evening between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

DAY 2

- 8:45 a.m. Breakfast
- 10:30 a.m. Levys' Guided Driving Tour of Manhattan. Hop on your motor coach to learn all about the Big Apple from a local New Yorker from Levys' Unique New York. You will see the Empire State Building, the Upper West Side, Wall Street, and more!
- 1:30 p.m. Explore Central Park. This iconic park, which is the most filmed location in the world, is a green oasis in the middle of the city. You will see Strawberry Fields, the memorial to John Lennon, the Alice in Wonderland sculpture and Rat Rock, a crop of large boulders left over by receding glaciers.
- 2:00 p.m. Lunch
- 3:00 p.m. Visit the Metropolitan Museum of Art. The Met, is one of the world's largest museums and features works from ancient Egypt to the modern times. In addition to the art, you will see musical instruments, costumes and antique weapons from around the world!
- 7:00 p.m. Major League Baseball Game. Peanuts, get your peanuts! Enjoy a major league baseball game with your students and hopefully you will see a home run! *Tickets are subject to schedules and availability of local teams*.

DAY 3

- 8:45 a.m. Breakfast
- 10:30 a.m. Staten Island Ferry. Travel between Whitehall Street in lower Manhattan to St. George on Staten Island on a gorgeous 25-minute ferry ride. Marvel at the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island and get a photo of the skyscrapers that make up the New York skyline.

- 11:00 a.m. Financial District Orientation Tour. Ring the opening bell, it's time to trade! Not only is the Financial District one of the oldest areas in the city, it is also the financial, political and judicial heart of the city. During this tour your students will learn all about: Wall Street, Trinity Church and Federal Hall.
- 12:00 p.m. Lunch
 - 1:15 p.m. Visit One World Observatory. In less than 60 seconds you will ascend to the top of the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere. Experience a panoramic view of New York City and the brave can step on a glass disc that uses footage to show the streets 100 floors below!
- 2:30 p.m. Visit the 9/11 Memorial. "Reflecting Absence" are twin reflecting pools that sit within the footprints of the towers. Your students will learn about the events of this day and will pay respects to the nearly 3,000 people who died in the terror attacks on September 11, 2001 and the six people killed during the bombing in February 1993.
- 3:30 p.m. Chinatown and Little Italy. Barter with shop owners for jewelry, clothing and bags in Chinatown and feast on cannoli, fresh mozzarella or prosciutto in Little Italy. Your students will leave inspired after learning about the history and culture of these neighbourhoods.
- **4:45 p.m. Walk along the High Line.** Experience New York City's architecture and biodiversity as you walk along the old rail tracks 30 feet above street level. This gorgeous walk runs through the Meatpacking District, Chelsea and Hell's Kitchen with many stops along the way for photos!
- **6:00 p.m. Times Square.** Head to the heart of NYC for dinner and time to explore!
- 8:00 p.m. **Broadway Show.** Explore a whole new world, discover what came before the yellow brick road or sing along with your favourite meerkat and warthog duo. *Theatre tickets are subject to schedule and availability.*
