

SEATTLE - 3 Days | U.S. Pacific Northwest Student Tour

DAY 1

From fresh-baked bread, local honey, and chocolate to artisanal crafts and jewelry, the Market will delight you!
- 12:30 p.m. Lunch
- 1:30 p.m. Visit the Pacific Science Centre. Hands-on exhibits, shows, and innovative programs (including the Planetarium, an IMAX documentary, or Laser Dome show) will ignite students' curiosity for science. This afternoon of exploration will enhance the curriculum and spark a lifelong interest in science, math, engineering, and technology.
- **4:00 p.m. Visit Chihuly Garden and Glass.** Discover blown glass by local artist Dale Chihuly as fine art in the galleries, Glasshouse, and lush garden.
- 5:15 p.m. Visit the Observation Deck at the Space Needle.

- 9:15 a.m. Photo Stop at Kerry Park. The unsurpassed view of Elliott Bay, and occasionally Mount Rainier in the background, will provide a fabulous opportunity for photos!

The foundation's mission is to reduce inequities related to poverty, health, and education affecting people all over the world. Using interactive exhibitions and handson activities, MoPOP helps students make connections between popular music, storytelling, writing, movies, comics, and the classroom curriculum.

Using 5K cameras, innovative art laser projection, drones for image capture, MUSHROOM VR™, and a ground-breaking surround sound system, Wings Over Washington will transport you on an aerial adventure over one of America's most beautiful states. Take a virtual journey as a spirit eagle: dive down the seaside cliffs through the morning mists of the Olympic National Forest and Mt. Rainier to the San Juan Islands, and on to the spectacular beauty of the Cascades and the awe-inspiring Snoqualmie Falls.
