SOUTH OF FRANCE & BARCELONA - 9 Days | European Student Tour

Day 1: Board your flight to Marseille.

Day 2: Marseille - Baux de Provence - Avignon

- Meet your tour leader at the airport.
- Start your day with a guided tour of the Baux de Provence, a beautiful town ideally located on a steep hill. The fortress that overlooks the village is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Travel to the city of Avignon and have dinner in a restaurant located near the Place de l'Horloge, the main square in the city.

Day 3: Avignon - Pont du Gard - Châteauneuf-du-Pape

- Enjoy a guided walking tour of Avignon's historical center, which is famous for the Palace of the Popes, one of the largest and most important medieval Gothic buildings in Europe, and the Saint-Bénézet Bridge.
- Visit the Pont du Gard, the ancient Roman aqueduct that's over 2,000 years old, and stroll along the du Gard River.
- Discover the Candy museum **Haribo** and learn the history while enjoying some tasty treats.

Day 4: Nîmes - Carcassonne

- Explore the Nîmes arena, a Roman amphitheatre built around AD 70 and still active as a bullring and other public events.
- Visit the Grotte des Demoiselles cave, which is among the most beautiful in the region and is filled with stalactite and stalagmite formations.
- Travel to Carcassonne.

Day 5: Carcassonne - Lastours

- Discover the city of Carcassonne with a guided tour.
 This medieval town was formerly a castle and has been occupied for more than 5,000 years.
- Enjoy free time in the medieval city and see the local shops and museums.
- Head over to the Châteaux Cathares in Lastours.
- Take a short hike to the four castles: Cabaret, Tour Régine, Surdespine and Quertineux. This dramatic setting on a rocky hill dates back to the crusade against the Albigeois.

• Travel back to Carcassonne for an evening stroll to the Old Bridge to view the illuminated medieval town.

Day 6: Figueras - Calella

- Start the day travelling to Figueras, Spain.
- Stop at the Dalí Museum, one of the most popular museums in Spain, to marvel at the surrealistic work of Salvador Dalí.
- Continue travelling towards Calella, a small town located on the Costa Brava and take advantage of the beautiful beach.

Day 7: Barcelona

- Head over to the centre of Barcelona to discover the masterpieces of talented architect Antoni Gaudí and stroll on the luxurious passeig de Gracia to see beautiful examples of Modernisme architecture.
- Visit the extraordinary Sagrada Familia Cathedral by Gaudí and venture to the top of the towers to see a great view of Barcelona.
- Stroll through Park Güell, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and another of Gaudi's works. Here you will see two fairy pavilions, many galleries, a large bench covered in mosaics and Salá Hipostila, a forest of columns.
- Tour the **FC Barcelona soccer stadium**. Founded in 1899, it is the third largest soccer stadium in the world.

Day 8: Barcelona

- Spend the morning exploring the winding streets of the medieval quarter and see the Santa Maria del Mar Church, outside the Royal Palace, the Gothic Quarter and the Generalitat Palace.
- Enjoy free time visiting the famous Ramblas, a beautiful boulevard in the middle of the city centre. Don't miss the Boqueria, the open air market filled with all types of fresh produce.
- Learn the secret of paella with a workshop by professional chefs.

Day 9: Depart to the airport for your flight home.
